6. If the applicant has not studied qualifying examination in Andhra Pradesh, he/she shall submit following certificates as per regulation 5.2 to 5.6 whichever is applicable to the applicant.(Refer Prospectus)
  - (a) 10 Years Residence Certificate of the candidate in the State of A.P. (OR)
  - (b) 10 Years Residence Certificate of either of the Parents/Spouse (Certificate of relationship also shall be enclosed)

8. Candidates in State Quota claiming eligibility as Local / Non-Local should furnish relevant certificates in support of their claim.

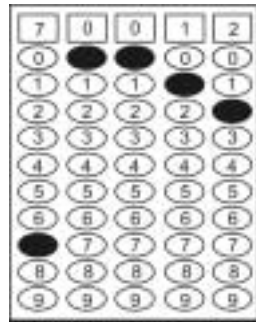
NOTE:
